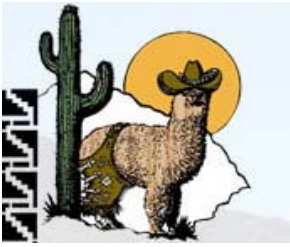

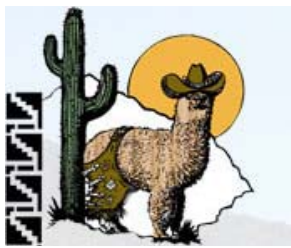

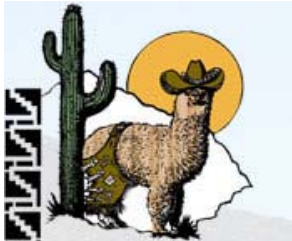

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General Information	Show Information
<p>The Southwest Regional Alpaca Show is an AOBA certified Level III show. Please register early to ensure your opportunity to participate. You are encouraged to join the AOBA Show Division and also to become familiar with the 2010 AOBA Show rules.</p> <p>Animal check-in and vendor check-in begins at 8:00 am Friday, March 12th, 2010. All alpacas entering the facility must have a valid veterinarian health certification dated within 30 days of the last day of the show.</p> <p>Please see the health requirement page below for detailed information and further discussion on Bovine Viral Diarrhea Virus (BVDV).</p> <p>As an added bio-security measure we will be performing the vet check inside the trailers this year. Our vets will have either disposable booties and /or will wash their feet in a bleach solution.</p> <p>The microchip number must be written on the health certification for each animal. We will have a veterinarian on site for animal inspections. Any animal failing the veterinarian exam or failure to produce the required documents will not be allowed into the facility.</p> <p>Stalls are 8 x 8 on concrete floor. Stall bedding (grass hay) will be provided. Reminder: concrete floors can sometimes be slippery. You can bring alternative floor cover such as floor mats if you so desire, in fact is highly suggested. No more than three animals per stall are allowed; please use discretion on number of animals. All animals must be 6 months or older. Please take advantage of our vendor area for your product sales. No sale of merchandise from the stall area.</p> <p>If you wish to stall by another exhibitor please indicate so on the Exhibitor Registration Form. We will do our best to honor such requests. If you have a display stall setup preference, please include a rough drawing of your desired stall layout on a separate piece of paper. This will help us tremendously on setup day.</p> <p>Electrical outlets are available for \$55. Please bring your own extension cord(s). Remember to check the box on the registration form if you desire an electrical hook-up.</p> <p>Water is available.</p>	<p>Per AOBA rules:</p> <p>All alpacas must be entered in the name of the owner as per the ARI registration. If the animal has been sold but the registration has not been processed by ARI then a "Owner of Record for Show Entry" form must be filled out and included with the registration.</p> <p>If you are not a member of the AOBA Show Division, we are required to charge a \$75 show fee (per farm). This fee pays for you to show animals at OUR SHOW only. You will owe this fee again at your next show; it does not pay for the AOBA show division membership. If you are not a member of the AOBA Show Division we strongly suggest becoming a member and procuring a AOBA Show Division number.</p> <p>AOBA requires a \$6 fee for every animal entered. This is included in your registration fee.</p> <p>Important: Participants and Vendors: please enter through the Corporate Gate at 17th. Ave. and McDowell Rd.</p> <p>No plastic is required on the floor under the stalls.</p> <p>Make a copy of your health certificate to give to us at Vet Check. Keep your original health certificates to travel with. Be careful not to make any marks on your original health cert as that could give you problems if you are stopped in transit.</p> <p>Show ring attire should be clean and neat in appearance. White shirt and black pants or white blouse/top and black or dark pants/skirts are recommended but not mandatory.</p> <p>No banners/signs/etc can be directly affixed to the walls or any part to the buildings. If you need anything hung on the building please notify us in advance, as the AZ State Fairgrounds personnel must provide this service, for an additional fee.</p> <p>Please take advantage of our vendor area for your product sales. 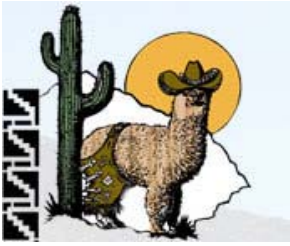

Health Requirements

The Southwest Regional Alpaca Show will require that ALL alpacas entering the show venue, this includes animals that will be entering the show ring, Male Sale animals, and companion animals, be tested for BVDV in addition to the mandated state health requirements as listed below.

BVDV TESTING

Acceptable BVDV tests include either a negative PCR test or a negative VI test that was run on your animal at any time in its life. We are screening for true PI's only and therefore a negative from any age is sufficient for our purposes at the show.

(PCR = Polymerase Chain Reaction VI = Virus Isolation)

VI test: a negative VI test **performed at any age.**

PCR test: a negative PCR test **performed at any age.**

The test results must be written on the CVI by a licensed veterinarian. Although not required, please bring a copy of the test results with you - it will speed up the check-in process.

The veterinarian who completes the CVI must list the following information directly on the CVI

- The negative BVD test result
- The date of BVD testing
- The lab that did the testing
- The accession number of the test (every lab will list this with the results)
- The METHOD OF TESTING (PCR or VI)

ARIZONA HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Certificates of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) and microchips will be checked before alpacas will be admitted into the facility.

All Alpacas entering the venue must be micro-chipped.

(NOTE: microchip numbers must be WRITTEN on the CVI at the time of [veterinary health](#) inspection by the licensed veterinarian. The stick-on label containing the printed microchip number is not acceptable).

AZ and NON-AZ RESIDENTS MUST HAVE:

A Veterinary Health Certificate (CVI) completed and signed by a licensed Veterinarian within 30 days of the last day of the show with the following included on the CVI:

- Negative BVDV testing either PCR or VI as noted above
- Alpaca ARI Name
- Microchip number written on CVI by licensed veterinarian at time of CVI

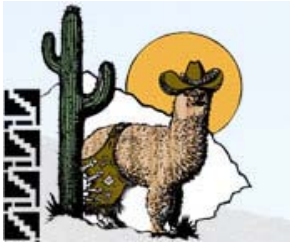

2010 Mandatory Exhibitor Disclosure

Under the Show Division Handbook Rules, certain alpacas and fleeces are automatically disqualified from competition and certain Exhibitors & Handlers are prohibited from personally showing in front of a Judge when a business or financial relationship exists between an AOBA Certified Judge and their customers.

Each year at contract renewal time, our Judges are required to disclose those alpacas, exhibitors and handlers who cannot be shown in their show ring when judging at an AOBA Certified show. Exhibitors are also required to disclose business and financial relationships with Judges and to acknowledge animals/fleece entered into the competitions that are not allowed to show in front of certain Judges at each show they attend. This is being done to ensure Exhibitors understand the written rules and to eliminate confusion for Exhibitors & Handlers about which alpacas, Exhibitors & Handlers cannot walk into a Judge's show ring during competition and which fleeces cannot be entered into a Fleece Show.

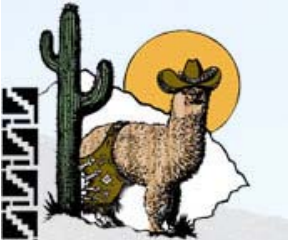

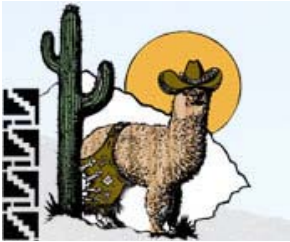

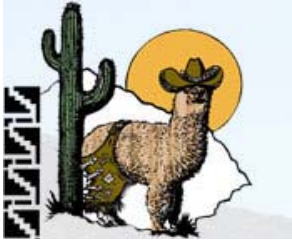

Male Sale

The Southwest Regional Alpaca Show has a 'Male Sale' at the show that receives rave reviews every year. What a great opportunity to bring along a male alpaca and give him exposure to potential buyers. In past years boys sold at prices from \$1000 to \$25,000, so this is a great way to sell males at any price. Many of the boys offered in the Male Sale are SOLD at the show and we have heard that owners also received calls from potential customers long after the show was over! The Male Sale catalog can be a reference for potential buyers long after the show ends.

- Your male-for-sale will get to stand out at the show while **wearing a male-for-sale tag** and having a **male-for-sale sign** on his stall - and of course, you can provide promotional material on him at your stall. *The "I'm For Sale" tag should be returned to ABA at the end of the show.*
- Entrants can be **intact or gelded**; they can be sold with or without a reproductive warranty.
- Entrants **do not have to be entered** in show classes to participate in the Male Sale, however they do need to be present at the show.
- Entrants are to be sold with the **seller's guarantee of health** as of the date of the sale. Any other guarantees (such as reproductive soundness, fertility, etc.) are to be by private arrangement between the parties.
- Entrants must carry written evidence of good health, defined as an interstate travel certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian within 30 days prior to the last day of the show. Males-for-sale will go through the same Vet Check to come into the show arena that all halter show entries do.
- Entrants must be micro-chipped and the chip number must be written on their health certificate.
- Entrants are required to be **ARI registered**. A copy of the Male's ARI certificate must be provided along with your show registration.
- Show management will prepare a **Male Sale Catalog** based on photo and information provided by the seller that will be available to all show participants and the public audience at the show. Photos will be rendered in black & white for the catalog.
- Show management will provide Buyer and Seller with copies of the Alpaca Breeders of Arizona non-reproductive **Alpaca Purchase Contract** (ABA recommends that the parties of the sale use this contract or a more restrictive one of their choosing. ABA accepts no responsibility for any issues arising out of the sponsorship of the Male Sale.)
- The **cost to enter** an alpaca in the Male Sale is only \$50 for alpacas priced under \$2500 and \$75 for alpacas priced \$2500 and up. There is no limit on the asking price.

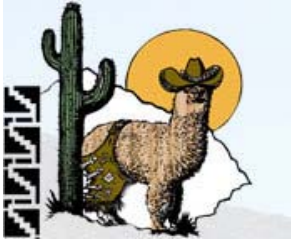

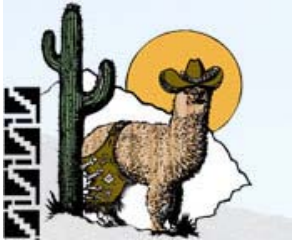

Ribbons will be given from 1st through 5th.

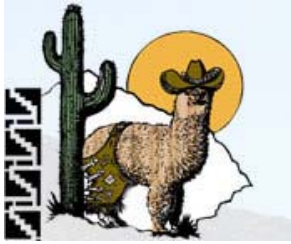

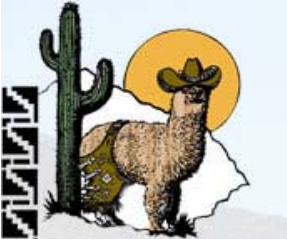

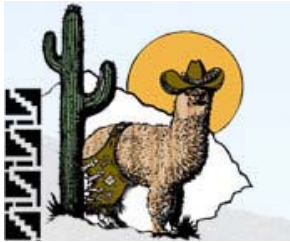
